

Dr Michiel de Haan is a professor of Interventional Radiology at the Maastricht University Medical Center. He received his M.D. at the University of Leiden in 1986. After a brief, three year period as surgical resident he was offered a position as resident in radiology at the University of Maastricht. After finishing his training, dr de Haan switched to the University of Leuven (Belgium) for a fellowship in Interventional Radiology. Returning to Maastricht dr de Haan became the head of the department of Interventional Radiology in 1996. He is registered Fellow of the Cardiovascular and Interventional Radiological Society of Europe (CIRSE) and is member of the Dutch Society of Interventional Radiology. His specific IR interests lie in fields of endovascular treatment of complex thoracic-abdominal aneurysms, dialysis access interventions and percutaneous recanalization of - post-thrombotic- central venous occlusions.
