

Ulf Hedin did his PhD in vascular cell biology 1989, trained in vascular surgery 1991-2001 at the Karolinska Hospital and completed a fellowship with Prof. Alexander W Clowes, Seattle, WA, USA in 1995-1996. After his return to Karolinska, he started an independent research group and a prospective biobank of carotid endarterectomies (BiKE), a recognized effort which today enrolls collaborations in the US, Canada, and Europe (Germany, Holland, UK) with recent publications in Nature, Nature Medicine, Nature Metabolism, and Nature Communications. Apart from his translational research in thromboembolic carotid disease, he has a strong clinical focus on vascular access and he was the co-founder of the Swedish Vascular Access meeting, a bi-annual national transdisciplinary effort to improve national access care since 2008. Hedin was appointed professor in 2003, holds the academic chair of vascular surgery since 2005 and is senior consultant in vascular surgery at the Karolinska University Hospital. He has been on the writing committee for the recent ESVS Vascular Access Guidelines, and served on the ESVS council, the VAS council, the Swedish Research Council, the council of the Swedish Heart-Lung Foundation, and he is a member of the International Surgical Group and the Research Council of the Lundbeck Foundation.
