

Ramon Roca-Tey's research interest is focused on the field of vascular access for haemodialysis which has resulted in a doctoral thesis, 6 awards, 200 papers and communications in national and international congresses and various Chapters of books and scientific articles published in medical journals. He has been council member of the Catalan Society of Nephrology (2010-2014). He is council member of the Vascular Access Society (VAS), coordinator of the Spanish Multidisciplinary Group on Vascular Access (GEMAV), coordinator of the vascular access for haemodialysis working group of the Spanish Society of Nephrology (SEN), coordinator of the vascular access for haemodialysis working group of the Catalan Society of Nephrology (SCN) and member of the Interventional Nephrology Working Group of the SEN (promoting group). He has been co-chair of the work group of the "Spanish Clinical Guidelines on Vascular Access for Haemodialysis" (2017) and an external reviewer of the Vascular Access Clinical Practice Guidelines of the European Society of Surgery (2018). He has also participated in the organization of various courses and conferences, including the 9th Congress of Vascular Access Society 2015 (Chair).
